WHEREAS, one in five children and adults may have a specific learning disability; and,


WHEREAS, specific learning disabilities consist of a range of neurological conditions that interfere with the ability to store, process, or produce information; and,


WHEREAS, specific learning disabilities may include dyslexia, dysgraphia, ADHD, and other processing disorders; and,
